in the ascendancy.

Chennam is a regular
center to create Y.M.C.A. workers,
i.e. Protestant preachers, of
both sexes. They have the

personnel and the financial
resources. Next year the 11th
and 12th grade are to be added
to the 10 already existing.
The children will was so
proud, that they cannot be
approached any longer. The
Catholic cause ought to be
revitalized by the presence
of several catholic teachers. This
is my latest view of the
conditions existing at the
Cherrawaschool presently.
