Dear Mr. Kelly:

We are, indeed, pleased with the prayer books and rosaries you have been kind enough to send for our Indian boys and girls. Haskell Institute, which they attend, is just a short distance from Lawrence, and the Catholic students come in to the parish church every Sunday. During the regular school year we Sisters teach them Catechism after Mass, and prepare the younger children for receiving their first Holy Communion. This year Bishop Johannes administered the Sacrament of Confirmation, about fifty of the Haskell students receiving it.

Just at present many of the boys and girls are away at their homes, so we do not conduct our Catechism classes. When school reopens in the fall, we shall have special instructions on the saying of the rosary. You may be sure we shall not forget our benefactors in our prayers. Every Sunday when we Sisters say the beads with the Indian students during Mass we remember those who have been generous in helping promote God's honor, and devotion to our Blessed Mother.
