Formerly the Donors Forum of Wisconsin, Wisconsin Philanthropy Network (WPN) is a 501(c)(3) professional membership association of grantmakers.

What do we do?

We work to support and promote effective philanthropy in Wisconsin, by providing our members with networking opportunities, skill-building programming, and research services. WPN is one of 34 regional associations across the country that works to promote philanthropy.

Who is eligible for membership?

WPN membership represent a diverse group of independent and family foundations, corporate foundations and giving programs, community foundations, and other grantmaking organizations from across the state.
