



## ACCREDITED COMMUNITY FOUNDATIONS



Wisconsin is a national leader in the community foundation field. Wisconsin’s community foundations, coordinated by Wisconsin Philanthropy Network (formerly Donors Forum of Wisconsin), were the first in the nation to develop a certification process for community foundations.

Community Foundations are nonprofit organizations with the goal of strengthening Wisconsin's communities. An accredited community foundation has confirmed compliance with *The National Standards for U.S. Community Foundations*<sup>™</sup>. According to the National Standards website, to achieve a confirmation of compliance, community foundations must undergo, “an extensive review of their organizational and financial policies and procedures.”

Wisconsin's Certified Community Foundations administer and invest charitable funds for individuals, families and corporations, supporting Wisconsin's communities through grants and community leadership.
